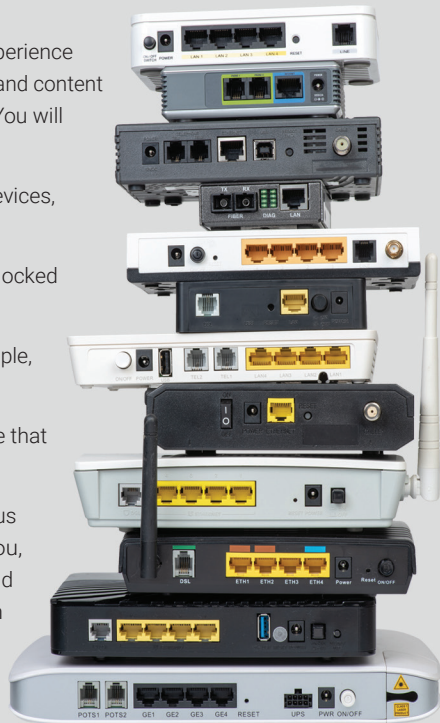

RESTARTING A FIRE TV STICK

You can use an Amazon Fire TV Stick to view our app based streaming TV service, prtvnw! Like most devices, even your Fire TV Stick can suffer from performance issues and has to be troubleshooted. There are three fairly simple methods for restarting your Fire TV Stick and should only take a few minutes.

1. Restart your Fire TV Stick using your remote – On your remote, press and hold the "Play/Pause" button and the "Select" button simultaneously for a few seconds until your Fire TV Stick powers off. Your Fire TV Stick will automatically restart.

2. Restart your Fire TV Stick in settings – On the Amazon Fire Stick home screen on your TV, scroll to the right and highlight "Settings." Scroll down and click "My Fire TV." In "My Fire TV," scroll down and click on "Restart." Your Fire TV Stick will automatically restart.

3. Unplug your Fire TV Stick – Locate where the Fire TV Stick is connected to power, and unplug it from the outlet. After unplugging it, wait a few seconds and plug your Fire TV Stick back in. Your Fire TV Stick will automatically restart.
